Do it all in a short stay

The "Executive Trip" is specifically designed to provide maximum adventure and fishing in four days of fishing. Float plane transfers, full days of Salmon, Halibut and Trout, and fly out fishing are all packed into four days of action. You also get an extra overnight at the lodge. So if you have a short time but still want to do it all- This is the trip!



Day 1 We'll make first-day arrangements for your 1:30 pm floatplane to the lodge. We'll get you settled into your riverfront cabin and you and the beach guide can cast on the beach before happy hour, dinner, and overnight at the main lodge.

Day 2 Fly-out fishing adds another dimension to the Alaska experience and often can provide a special angling experience. We will choose hot spots for Mountain Grayling on each day's adventure. Typically fly-outs allow for a little extra morning sleep prior to departure and get you back in time for happy hour.

Day 3 Trophy Trout in the Wildlife Refuge is all that you've dreamed it could be - clear mountain water, beautiful drifts, and great fishing. Two to four anglers per drift boat wade the Upper Kenai River in search of Char, Silvers, Sockeye, and especially Rainbow Trout. (Your choice of Halibut or Salmon on trips prior to 6/15).

Day 4 Giant Pacific Halibut are offshore in the Cook Inlet or the waters surrounding Kenai Fjords National Park. You and five others will fish for Halibut, Cod, Bass and possibly Salmon, while viewing glaciers, Puffins, Otter and Killer Whales.

Day 5 One more morning charter for Salmon, or you may opt to wade a mountain stream for Char or float tube a Wilderness lake for Rainbow Trout, before returning to the lodge for your scheduled float plane return to Anchorage at 2:30pm (included).
